GUIDELINES FOR REVIEWERS

If you'd like to write for us, please keep the following in mind:

- Reviews should be a minimum of 500 words (around 750 is average – but no more than 1500).
- Please include two or three quotes from the book of a sentence or two each to illustrate your points and give a flavour of the writing.
- Make sure you let readers know in the first paragraph what kind of book it is, eg novel, history, memoir, etc.
- Resist using too much personal 'I-voice' reaction – ie keep your review as objective as you can – though if you look at the reviews on the site you'll see that personal reaction can work quite well in some cases.
- Critical reviewing is welcomed, but please don't review books you can't in any way recommend as worth reading. Life's too short.
- Please include publication details at the end of your review, specifically: author, title, publisher, year of publication, format (hardback or paperback or ebook), number of pages and recommended retail price.
- Don't forget to add a sentence or two about yourself to run at the end of the review.
